

Lesson Plan Year 10 Al-Ashraf RE on Christianity

<p>Learning Outcomes:</p>	<p>To become familiar with the terms incarnation, crucifixion, resurrection and ascension in the Christian Tradition</p> <p>To understand what Christians believe and what their beliefs mean to them through studying hymns and creeds used in Christian worship</p>
<p>Introduction</p>	<p>Church of England is part of the Anglican Church</p> <p>Anglicans say 'if you want to know what we believe, look at our worship'</p> <p>Looking at some key Christian beliefs today all focused on what Christians believe about Jesus:</p> <p>Incarnation Crucifixion Resurrection Ascension</p>
<p>Specific Tasks</p>	<p>1. To read through the Nicene Creed and to see if you can match each of these words to part/s of the creed - many (not all) Christians will say these words together as part of their Sunday worship as a declaration of belief and trust in God</p>
<p>Feedback to class</p>	<p>Describe what the different words refer to</p>
	<p>2. To look at one of the songs (which are sung in Christian worship) with a partner and to identify which Christian beliefs are represented in the words of the song</p> <p>3. To see what you can learn from these songs about what the beliefs of incarnation, crucifixion, resurrection and ascension might mean for a Christian in their day to day life</p>
