They have no fixed source of income and rely on charity to cover their needs. The family needs help covering their essential daily needs, help for paying for maintenance work and painting on their house. The beneficiary would also benefit from a bed. Doa'a is in good health, but she and her sister need orthopedic shoes to provide support for their feet (flat foot).</p>
